





PREMIUM ROCK ART TOUR

Nganjarli
(Murujuga National Park)

Take a guided tour with a Traditional Owner through Nganjarli - Murujuga National Park and discover the petroglyphs (rock art) created by the Yaburrara (Northern Ngarluma) people. The rock art has been dated back to before the ice age ended and is approximately over 40,000 years old, with up to 1 million rock art images scattered across the entire Burrup Peninsula and Dampier Archipelago.

& surrounds


Discover the awe-inspiring beauty of the Pilbara's hidden treasures. Your journey extends beyond the visual marvels as Traditional Owners impart knowledge about Bush Medicine, unveiling the secrets of the region's flora and their traditional healing properties. Along the way explore the diverse array of native plants and foods that have sustained generations.

Duration: 8-10 Hours (approx.)



ROCK ART TOUR

Yaburrara (Karratha)



Embark on a two-hour guided tour along the Yaburrara Trail with a traditional owner, where you will have the opportunity to rediscover ancient petroglyphs crafted by the Yaburrara people. The trail, nestled along a ridge, unveils a rich tapestry of petroglyphs dating back over 6,000 years, offering a captivating glimpse into the enduring cultural legacy of the Northern Ngarluma people.

UNDER THE STARS NIGHT TOUR

Hearson's Cove



Journey through landscapes and engage in the living traditions of the local Aboriginal people of the area.

This celestial event takes place once a month, aligned with the new moon, providing an intimate setting for this cultural exchange. Prepare to be captivated by the beauty of nature, the warmth of the fire, and the richness of Aboriginal traditions during this unforgettable evening under the stars.

ROCK ART & BUSHFOOD TOUR

Nganjarli (Murujuga National Park)




Journey through time and culture as you explore Nganjarli (Deep Gorge) in Murujuga National Park, boasting the highest concentration of rock ancient art in the world, created by the Yaburrara people. Immerse yourself in the coastal landscapes as you forage under the guidance of your local guide and explore the bounty of the land, discovering seasonal native bush tucker.

Duration: 4 Hours (approx.)



COSSACK WALKING TOUR

Cossack



A 60-minute walking tour of Bajinhurba (Cossack) on Ngarluma Country. Cossack is a town that pulsates with the echoes of history and culture, just 50 kilometres from Karratha. This tour promises not only a glimpse into the history of Cossack's pearling era and maritime industry, but also an intimate connection with the land and its enduring stories of culture.

Duration: 60 minutes (approx.)
